Regional average earnings per job are **\$18.1K below** the national average earnings of \$75.5K per job.

Takeaways

- As of 2021 the region's population **increased by 1.0%** since 2016, growing by 18,645. Population is expected to **increase by 1.5%** between 2021 and 2026, adding 27,374.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs declined by 1.5% in PSO- Served Oklahoma Counties from 791,714 to 780,067. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.4% by 1.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.9% to 59.9% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.3% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.0% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.


Educational Attainment







Unemployment by Ethnicity

















Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Location Quotient









Top Occupation Location Quotient








